- Enforcing walking/family responsibility zones;
- Eliminating after-school transportation for daycares that are outside the school's attendance zone, other than the established partners of the division;
- Establishing alternative service routes, or hub bus stops, for STEAM, PLATO, and Noel C. Taylor Learning Academy.

Bus routes for the 2024-2025 school year will be available in August. (Bus stops may change from prior year and students may have to walk to their stop in accordance with family responsibility zones.)
