NOTE: Lock-down Drill Notice

Each year, Virginia law requires schools to conduct lock-down drills. Virginia law also requires parents and guardians receive at least 24 hours' notice prior to each lock-down drill. On Friday, 9/13, we conducted our first lock-down drill. Our staff and students did a wonderful job practicing the safety procedures. Later this week, Wasena Elementary School will conduct the second required lock-down drill. As part of these drills, there will be a lock-down announcement broadcast throughout the school. We ask you continue to speak with your children about the importance of taking these drills seriously and following all instructions. Our Preschool and Kindergarten students are exempt from the lockdown drills within the first 60 days of school. We thank you for your understanding as we work to maintain a safe learning environment for our students.
